Committee Action:

- 1) 11-10-06 Minutes
Frederick moved. Rowse seconded to approve the 11-10-06 DCC minutes.
Motion passed unanimously
- 2) CMT rubric and Departments Requiring a CMT course
Hughey moved. Frederick seconded to recommend to APAC that a rubric be created for Critical and Multicultural Thinking courses and that departments should not be able to require a specific CMT course as part of the major.
Motion passed with 6 in favor, 1 abstention
- 3) MDS 109: Freshmen Seminar in Higher Education (CMT)
Proposal was returned to the department. The proposal must show where critical and multicultural thinking is being incorporated in the course.
- 4) SPAN 122: Introduction to Latin American Culture & Civilization
Hughey moved. Leonard seconded to approve Span 122 in the L.S. Division F area. The course already has DC designation in Competency #7 so it will carry dual designation.
Motion passed unanimously
- 5) HON 200: Honors Colloquium
Proposal was returned to the department. Hughey and Sankey are members of the Honors Program Committee and they were not sure if this proposal was supposed to be part of the Honors package. If the Honors Program brings the proposal back to the DCC, they must show consultation with Philosophy and English as well as address how they will deal with the consistency issue of the course when it is being taught by different instructors.
- 6) HON 301: Masterpieces of Literature
Proposal was returned to the department. The proposal must demonstrate how critical and multicultural thinking outcomes will be applied.
- 7) HON 312: Journeys in Literature: Classical & Medieval Masterpieces
Proposal was returned to the department. The course must draw on two Foundation Four courses.
