- 1) 10-30-08 Minutes
Frederick moved. Hughey seconded to approve the 10-30-08 minutes.
Motion passed unanimously.
- 2) HUM 302 Liberty and Civic Responsibility in America
Clapp moved. Rowse seconded to approve HUM 302 in the Outer Cluster, DC 9: Ethical and Civic Responsibility.
Motion passed with 9 in favor, 0 opposed, 2 abstentions.
- 3) AMCS 390 Asian Adoption in America
Kim Park Nelson and Zachary Machunda were present to answer questions.
Hughey moved. Dolence seconded to approve AMCS 390 in the Outer Cluster, DC 8: Global Perspective.
Park Nelson explained that she is proposing this course in DC 8 because it is transnational and emphasizes the cultural and economical climate in Asian countries who seek out an adoption relationship with the U.S.
DCC supports the course but does have concerns with the American connection. If it is submitted for permanent designation as a new course, some committee members would like to see it include other examples of international adoption in order to better fit the global aspect of this area.
