

Course Sequences

This document provides you with two sets of information. First, you will find a table that identifies specific prerequisite courses in the Special Education Program. The remaining tables provide a course sequence for completing each of the special education licensure programs individually or in combination. Use these tables to assist you with planning an appropriate program.

Many of the 1st and 2nd semester classes are prerequisites to courses the department has identified as appropriate for the senior year. Departmental faculty have carefully planned this sequence to allow for introduction of knowledge and skills in early coursework, and expansion and application of knowledge and skills in later coursework. Following this prescribed sequence of courses provides you with a high quality program. It also supports efficient planning that will allow you to graduate on schedule. Be sure to pay attention to the prerequisites in the first table if you diverge from the prescribed licensure programs found in the remaining tables.
