The department has a generous scholarship program. A cumulative GPA of 3.0 and outstanding achievement in academics, artistic/creative activities, or department service are required to be eligible for the scholarships. Three scholarships are annually available to department majors, as described below. The deadline for application is February 27.

DELMAR J. HANSEN SCHOLARSHIP

The Delmar J. Hansen Scholarships are made possible by donations to the Delmar J. Hansen endowment fund by faculty, staff, alumni, and friends of the department. The program recognizes outstanding academic achievement as well as contributions to the department and community through leadership and active participation in events and organizations.

CAROL GAEDE SCHOLARSHIP

The Carol Gaede Scholarship Award was established to honor Dr. Carol Gaede for her long-standing commitment to excellence and learning in the disciplines of Communication Studies, Film Studies, and Theatre Arts. The scholarship is a financial award that honors academic, artistic/creative, and/or service achievement in a student who is a declared departmental major.

MARK ROBERT LUKAC SCHOLARSHIP

The Mark Robert Lukac Scholarship in Theatre and Film is an endowed fund which was established in memory of Mark Robert Lukac, who was a member in good standing of the Moorhead State University Class of 1991 at the time of his sudden, accidental death on April 8, 1990. This scholarship shall be awarded to a major who is studying theatre or film.
