INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS

The Transfer scholarships is made possible by donations made to the MSU Moorhead Foundation by alumni and friends of the University. The scholarship recognizes outstanding academic achievement, as well as contributions to the campus and community through leadership and active participation in events and organizations.

Fill out the "Applicant Information" section and attach an academic transcript from your final semester of attendance with the final cumulative GPA. Your application will not be considered without the final academic transcript (transcript does not need to be an official transcript).

The Phi Theta Kappa scholarship is part of the transfer scholarship program and the applicant needs to meet the same eligibility criteria as the transfer scholarship. If eligible and selected, you will be awarded either a Transfer Scholarship or a Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship (not both).

Students must meet the following criteria:

- Applicants must be a U.S. citizen seeking their first undergraduate degree.
- Undergraduate transfer students with a minimum of 24 successfully completed credits.
- Applicants must plan to be enrolled for a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester at MSUM.
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.5 from the school you are transferring from.

(Students can be awarded only ONE MSUM academic scholarship excluding talent scholarships)

These programs require completion of the 2012-2013 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) available at www.fafsa.gov. Early application is recommended to avoid delays in receiving funds. MSUM priority date for SEOG, Work Study, and Perkins Loans is February 15 of each year.
