This application allows you to be considered for the Upper Class/Transfer Honors Apprentice Scholarship. Please read the Required Documents section carefully and note the April 2 deadline.

The Upper Class/Transfer Honors Apprentice Scholarship is a \$10,000 award (\$5,000 per year for the final two years of a student's attendance based on academic performance). Included is the opportunity to apprentice in an area of interest under a faculty member's supervision. One student from each college and one college at large will be selected (5 total awards).

Students must meet the following criteria:

- Officially admitted to Minnesota State University Moorhead or a current student in good standing;
- Students are in their second semester of the sophomore year or later, but who have two years remaining to complete their bachelor's degree;
- Applicants must be seeking their first undergraduate degree;
- Applicant must be enrolled for a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester at MSUM;
- Minimum 3.5 cumulative GPA at the end of fall 2011 semester.
- Completion of five hours per week of apprenticeship is required for renewal.

3. Provide a resume of offices you have held and activities in which you have participated (please include school and community organizations, work experience, volunteer work, etc.)
