VISION^{1 2}

An empowered and vibrant regional human services delivery system in Eastern North Dakota and West Central Minnesota.

MISSION

The Human Services Resource Center provides advocacy, collaboration, coordination, consultation, education, empowerment, and support services to regional professionals and their organizations to ensure a vibrant regional human services delivery system in North Dakota and Greater Minnesota.
