PRIZES

- To the overall winner; **The Peter's Cup** with the winner's name and year of victory engraved and attached to the trophy for perpetuity. The winner will be able to keep and display THE CUP in their home or business for approximately one year or until the next UGCIT is contested. (Or until one year when everyone loses interest and it goes for up sale on eBay.)

CASH PRIZES

- Total prizes will be based on the total number of Golfers playing.
- \$15.50 / golfer goes to the prize pool.
 - 40% to the Peter's Cup Overall Champion
 - 10% for the Miniature Golf Event Winner
 - 10% for the Disc Golf Event Winner
 - 20% for the 2-man Team Event Winner
 - 10% each for the Handicapped (Net) and
 - 10% for the Scratch (Gross) Individual Golf Event Winners.

Ties will split the Cash Prize for each event or the overall. If we have 16 golfers, the prize pool will be \$323, 10% is \$32.30, For 24 golfers; \$487, etc... Invite your friends!

Winning The PETER'S CUP

The Peter's 1966 Pro Member Champion Trophy, a.k.a The Peter's Cup, will be bestowed upon the player with the lowest number of **Ultimate Golfer Points** collected across all events.

- **Ultimate Golfer points** will be based on the player's finish in each of the event. A point will be given for each golfer bested in the event. Example: 16 players, you win first outright: you get 15 points. Last place guy = 0 points.
- Each Player's worst Event (in **Ultimate Golfer Points**) will be thrown out before the final results are tabulated. Note: Any/all players that do not compete in a game will receive last place - 0 points.
- In the event of a tie for the Overall Champion after all the scheduled games are played, the tied players will split the prize money, but compete in a 9 "hole" playoff in Quarter-Bounce Golf for the right to have their name engraved on the Cup. Lowest Score will win the Cup!

PICTURES/Video

- In order to fully capture the special memories of the event, players are encouraged to take pictures and/or video throughout the days' events, especially competition and other humorous activities. Digital is preferred (especially since there is no developing costs), but if you were using film, a copy of your doubled prints would be OK. Please send all pictures and video to Randy ASAP following the event.
- All players will receive a DVD (or CD) with pictures from the event and the video presentation of the History of the Peter's Cup shortly after the event.

Miniature Golf

Event Codes: MGG

Official rules of golf play will be borrowed from the US Pro Mini Golf Association from <http://www.usprominigolfassn.com/tour.html>. Additional course rules may apply. If there is a difference, the Tournament Judges will make the ruling.

Stroke Play – Gross

- Score = Actual strokes, plus penalties, minus Mulligans*
- **Ultimate Golfer Points** will be by position vs. the field.

Special UGCIT instructions for Miniature Golf:

- OASIS supplied ball must be used.

Disc Golf

Event Codes: DGG

Official rules of Disc Golf play will be from the Pro Disc Golf Association http://www.pdga.com/select_all_rules.php. – PLEASE READ AND UNDERSTAND THESE RULES!!

Stroke Play – Gross

- Score = Actual throws, plus penalties, minus Mulligans*
- **Ultimate Golfer Points** will be by position vs. the field.

Special UGCIT instructions for Disc Golf:

- All MALE players OVER 16 years old or UNDER 65 year old will use the BACK Tees.
- A Mini Marker Disc MUST be used per normal PDGA tournament rules.
You will receive a Mini Marker Disc as part of this tournament. Remember, we play like the pros...We are playing for money and prestige!!

(More or less Regular ol') Golf

Official rules of golf play will be USGA from <http://www.usga.org/playing/rules/rules.html>. All 18 holes are w/cart. Men on White Tees, Women & Kids under 16 on Red Tees.

2-Man Team 3-Way Play Golf

Event Code: TG

2-Man Teams will compete on the first 9 holes of “regular” golf.

Teams can be made on your own, or the TD will pair you up with other singles. In the event of an odd number of participants, the odd man out will have to play the 9 holes of 2-Man Team by himself, however will have the option to use a Muligan for each Best Ball and Scramble hole (6 total) BUT not the Alternate shot holes.

- Teams will play 9 holes total, 3 in each of the following formats.
 - Holes 1st – 3rd SCRAMBLE
 - 2 Balls are played. The team chooses the better of the 2 ball positions, moves the other member’s ball to that area (within a club length), and continues to the hole.
 - Holes 4th – 6th ALTERNATE SHOT
 - One Ball is played. Each member advances the ball in turn tee-to-green.
 - Turns must carryover to the next tee.
 - HIT OUT of TURN = 1 stroke penalty.
 - Holes 7th – 9th BEST BALL (Best Score)
 - 2 Balls are played. Each member plays their own ball tee-to-hole.
 - Their better score is carded for the team.
- Handicap for the team is the Average of the 2 golfers (rounded up) (see below on handicap setting)
- **Ultimate Golfer Points** will be assessed by Team finish position vs. entire field of teams. Points will be doubled to weight the event properly. Both team members receive the same # points for the event.
- Cash Prize will be awarded to leading team of this event.

Individual Golf (Stroke play)

Event Codes: GS, NS

Gross and net games will be scored on the last 9 holes at St. John’s.

Stroke Play – Gross

- Score = Actual strokes, plus penalties, minus Mulligans*
- **Ultimate Golfer Points** will be by position vs. the field.
- Cash Prize will be awarded to leader of this game.

Stroke Play – Net [80% Handicap]

- Score = Gross - ((Your average for 9 Holes – Par)*0.8) {always round down}
- Those without an official or documented average will be assigned one by interview with the tournament director or a judge. Maximum for an undocumented average will be 58 (– or a handicap of 18/9).
- Ultimate Golfer Points will be by position vs. the field.
- Cash Prize will be awarded to leader of this event.

ÜBER RULES (regarding the entire competition)

Scorecards

- Only use one card per foursome for each of the Regular Golf, Disc Golf, and Miniature Golf.
- Only Gross Scores need to be recorded... The Secretaries will calculate all other scores.
- Foursomes will attest to all scores for the round then turn in their card to the Secretaries immediately after each event.

NO GIMMIES – *YOU MUST HOLE OUT*

Since this is serious competition, **NO GIMMIES** on short putts can be offered, or accepted.

- USGA RULE: The ball must be at rest at the bottom of the cup to be considered holed.
- PDGA RULE: **Holed-Out:** A term used to signify completion of a hole. A player has "holed-out" after the removal of the at rest disc from the chains or entrapment area of a disc entrapment device or after striking the marked area of the designated object target.
- US Pro-Mini Golf Tour RULE: Any ball putt in the hole must stay in the hole to be considered holed out. If a ball bounces out of the hole, it is not considered holed out and play must continue.

MULLIGANS – because we aren't pros.

MULLIGANS are a part of the way we all play golf; they should be a part of our tournament...with rules:

- One free Mulligan is allowed the player to be used anytime during the competition. Mulligans are only to be used on tee shots.
- All Mulligans must be used on the field of play – any unused Mulligans are forfeited.
- Additional Mulligans must be earned BEFORE used. 3 drinks = 1 Mulligan. A drink is a beer, a glass of wine, shot (minimum 80 proof), or a mixed drink.
- Maximum number of Mulligans for the tournament is 3. Drink maximum: well that's a different story. PLEASE Don't earn Mulligans and drive!!
- Your foursome will award Mulligans by witnessing the consumption.
- Underage Players and/or Designated Drivers or others who don't want the pressure will receive 1-2 additional Mulligans by flip of a coin. You cannot combine Mulligans received this way and by the consumption method.

BLOWUPS – because we aren't pros.

BLOWUPS: Maximum score on any hole is 10, except for the Miniature golf where it is 6.
Pick up your ball and get moving.
