Awarding Minnesota Resident Tuition to International Students.

All international students attending MSUM will be eligible for a Minnesota Resident Tuition Scholarship. Beginning in the Fall Semester 2010, new students will be eligible for the Minnesota Resident Tuition Scholarship the first semester they attend.

After the first semester, students must maintain standard academic progress and completed 10 hours of community service to continue to be eligible for the Minnesota Resident Tuition Scholarship. The 10 hours of community service must be completed each semester.

(Standard Academic Progress is defined as: Maintaining a 2.0 Cumulative GPA and a 67% course completion rate.)
