All semesters of non-enrollment will be included in the maximum limit. Academic performance and verified contribution hours will be evaluated each semester excluding summer session(s). Scholarship recipients who do not fulfill the requirements will be terminated from the program, and after one semester off the program, may reapply for the Scholarship. New recipients will be notified via e-mail after the beginning of the semester. The scholarship is canceled when Graduate students accept an assistantship.
