

Getting Class Permit (“Override”) to override MSUM Prerequisites.

- Usually if you didn’t take General Chemistry II at MSUM, or perhaps at another MNSCU school, you’ll need permission to get into Organic Chemistry I.
- Usually if you didn’t take Organic Chemistry I at MSUM (or perhaps another MNSCU school), you’ll need permission to get into Organic Chemistry II.

What to do if a class permit is required to register:

1. **Email** the following information to me at the following email address:
 - jasperse@mnstate.edu
2. **Information:** Include the following **information:**
 - a. Name
 - b. MSUM ID#
 - Note: If you’ve already applied and been admitted to MSUM, you’ll have an ID
 - c. Class (Organic I online or Organic II online)
 - d. Use the following email Subject Line: **“Override Request for Online Organic”**
 - e. Indicate where/how you satisfied the prerequisite(s). Examples:
 - “GenChem II at Calvin College, spring 2015”
 - “Organic I at Iowa State, Fall 2013”
