2012-2013 UPPER CLASS SCHOLARSHIP

Application for 2012-2013 Upper Class Scholarship is now available at web.mnstate.edu/finaid/Upper%20Class%20Scholarship%20App1.pdf. Students must meet following criterias to be eligible for the scholarship. Applicants must be seeking their first undergraduate degree, must be a currently enrolled student at MSUM who has completed at least 12 MSUM credits by the end of the current fall semester with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.25, must be enrolled for a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester at MSUM in order to receive their scholarship, not receiving an automatic continuing scholarship for 2012-2013 and not graduating by Summer 2012 or before (scholarship is for Fall 2012 and/or Spring 2013). Application and all other required documents must be received by 4:30pm on February 1, 2012.
