Tammy was named CEO of Border States on January 2, 2006. In preparation for her new responsibilities, she served as the company's President in 2005. Prior to 2005, Tammy was the Executive Vice President for the company. As EVP, Tammy wore two hats. She was the general manager for the Company's Southwest Region with branches in Phoenix, Tucson, Albuquerque, Farmington, El Paso and Juarez. She also served as Border States' CFO with responsibilities for accounting, finance, credit and legal. Tammy joined Border States in 1991 after working in public accounting for more than 8 years.
