It should be presented in black and white plus a color version with a maximum of up to 2 colors in addition to black and white (specified colors are PMS 576 Green and PMS 278 Blue)

Each proposal should include at least one treatment that incorporates the University's current symbol, the Dragon. The dragon logo and regulations associated with it are available at [web.mnstate.edu/ehs](http://web.mnstate.edu/ehs) click on Call For Entries

It should be adaptable to a wide variety of applications – letterheads, signs, faxes, caps, t-shirts, window decals, mugs, websites, and a student-owned-wind turbine

The selected entry will receive an award of \$300.00 and become the official logo of the MSUM Sustainable Campus Initiative and the sole property of the MSUM Sustainable Campus Committee

## Specifications:

The contest is open to all MSUM faculty, staff, and students

All entries must be mounted on a 15" by 20" black matte board

Limit of 2 entries per applicant – entries will not be returned

Proposals should be generated through a vector-based computer illustration program and saved as an editable EPS document

All entries must be identified with a 3" by 5" card taped to the back of the matte board in the lower right hand corner. Include your name, address, phone number, and email address
