Notes:

- The best 20 labs will be counted, out of about 25 overall.
- The labs will be collected frequently (average two a week) and late labs will not be accepted except in the case of *extended* illnesses.
- Labs will be collected in class, but may also be turned in to my office, Maclean 375 B, by 3:00 on the due date or whenever I start grading (whichever is later). Please slide it under my office door if I am not in. Do *not* turn it in to my mailbox in the Math office, as I will not likely find it by the time that I start grading.
- Each lab assignment will be scaled to a 10-point scale, so that all assignments have equal weight. When scaling labs, I do the calculation $\frac{(\text{earned points})}{(\text{possible points})} \cdot 10$ and round up if the decimal part starts with a 2 or higher.
- The Final Exam is comprehensive.
- The lowest of the five regular exams will be replaced with the grade on the Final Exam, assuming that the Final Exam grade is better. Note: The Final Exam will always count for at least 15% of your course grade. If you use it to replace your lowest exam grade as well, it will be 29% of your course grade.
- A makeup exam will only be given for valid, documented reasons. For official university activities that require that you miss an exam, you should provide me with a memo from the academic advisor or coach at least two weeks in advance of the test date. For illnesses, the assumption is that if you are ill enough to miss an exam, then you are ill enough to go to the health center and be checked out. They can provide you with a note stating that you were seen (it does not have to say what you were seen for). Other appropriate documentation would be a funeral notice, court order for jury duty, etc. Vacations are excusable *only* if you notify me of the dates by Tuesday September 3. The idea is that you will schedule family vacations or other events around the test dates if they are not already scheduled. If they are already scheduled, you should be able to check your schedule and let me know by Tuesday September 3.
