### BUZZ'S BODY SHOP

Last week, Buzz had to have lunch brought in for himself and his workers as there was no time to stop to eat. Chris and four other car owners had brought in their babies with various problems, in addition to wanting some of Buzz's buzz-worthy trademark graphics added to their cars. Buzz's garage was buzzing with activity from Monday through Friday, and by week's end, all his professional mechanics and artists were exhausted. From this information and the clues below, can you determine each day's car owner's full name (one last name is Costa), vehicle, repair work, and graphic added?

1. The SUV, which was brought in on Friday, didn't have the window tinting done.
2. The station wagon had a bumper ding and the one on Thursday had a loose rearview mirror.
3. Hutchinson was scheduled the day after the sports car and the day before Buzz added swirl graphics to a vehicle.
4. On Monday, Buzz worked on the one adding a sunburst graphic, and on Wednesday, he worked on Rogers' vehicle.
5. Kyle Garcia was a first-time customer, and Barb, who drives a pickup, comes in often for customizing jobs.
6. Buzz added a breaking wave graphic to the sedan and racing stripes to Mark's.
7. Peng came in the day after Selma and the day before the vehicle that had a luggage rack added.
8. The one with the broken door hinge was decorated with flames while it was in the shop.

Give a solution to the puzzle. Note that a solution consists of the explanation(s) and work that leads to the answer, as well as the answer itself. See the example handout from class.

Also note that Rogers' is the possessive form of the surname Rogers.
