Simple Tenses



Auxiliary + Main Verb Base (bare infinitive)

Does + Believe

Did + Believe

Will + Believe
```

Exception: Simple present and simple past affirmative statements delete the auxiliary and attach the tense affix directly to the base



Progressive Tenses

```
BE in desired tense + -ing main verb

Am + Walking

Was + Walking

Will be + Walking
```

Perfect Tenses

```
HAVE in desired tense + -en main verb

Has + Eaten

Had + Eaten

Will have + Eaten
```

Perfect Progressive Tenses

```
HAVE in desired tense + BEEN + -ing main verb

Has + Been + Working

Had + Been + Working

Will have + Been + Working
```

Passive Voice

```
BE in desired tense and aspect + -en main verb

Am + Beaten

Was being + Beate
```
