

Scanning Apps for Submitting Test Answers

- iPad users: If you don't have an iPad (or equivalent), you can write, save, and email electronic answers.
- Otherwise: You will need to **handwrite test answers, then scan them, and email** the scans. So, if you don't have an iPad, you'll want to have a scanner on your phone.

Recommended Free Scanners. Download App for your Phone:

Adobe Scan: Free, easy. Available for both iPhone and Android

- Scan each page, hit "keep scanning", then after the last page hit "Save PDF"
- Click "Share", select "Mail", enter jasperse@mnstate.edu, and send.
- Go to Adobe Scan "files", and delete the file.
- Go to your email, and delete the email

CamScanner:

- Select "batch"
- Scan each page, after the last page hit "Done"
- Hit share, select email, enter jasperse@mnstate.edu, and send.
- Go back to CamScanner home, click on "files", and delete the file.
- Go to your email, and delete the email

Note: For CamScanner, or for any of the other free scanners listed below, be careful not to accidentally approve a subscription account. If by mistake you do, go to your subscriptions and delete the subscription.
