

Tricollege Registration Summer 2024.

Tricollege registration will be accepted for both Organic I and Organic II during summer 2024.

- Note: **Registering directly through MSUM rather than via NDSU tricollege is significantly cheaper.**
 - **Minnesota students: \$403.38 cheaper** (\$1109.07 via MSUM, \$1512.45 via NDSU tricollege)
 - **North Dakota Students: \$265.47 cheaper** (\$1109.07 via MSUM, \$1374.54 via NDSU tricollege)
 - **Other states: \geq \$495.33 cheaper** (\$1109.07 via MSUM, \geq \$1604.40 via NDSU tricollege)
- **So, you can save yourself hundreds of dollars by directly registering through MSUM!**
 - Actually, reduce those differences by \$20, MSUM's application fee.
- Note: The above dollar listings include course fees, which will need to be paid directly to MSUM whether you take the course via MSUM or via tricollege registration.

NDSU Students, to Apply and Register via MSUM (this saves \$403 for Minnesotans, \$265 for North Dakotans

1. **APPLY TO MSUM as a "Non-degree seeking student":** <https://www.mnstate.edu/admissions/apply-now/>.

(Select "Undergraduate Application", then "non-degree seeking student").

- a. Online: Click the "Apply Online" button (from above link).

- **Create StarID first, and a password. Record these so you can access later! ☺ (You'll need them!)**
- Don't bother to fill in several pages about HS background etc.
- **Be sure to mark "Complete courses and transfer without a degree" and "Part Time Student" buttons**
- On page where it says "Major-Academic Program", don't enter anything
- **\$20 fee** at the end; should be box that says "Pay Now"; click on that and be able to submit payment

2. **To REGISTER FOR THE COURSE(S) through MSUM:** <http://www.mnstate.edu/eservices/>

- a. You'll need your StarID and password to login to link
- b. "Courses and Registration" will be on the left.
- c. Choose "Quick Add (Register)" and specify your course ID of interest.
 - a. 000064 CHEM350-01 Organic Chemistry I. May-15 listed start date (although can start sooner or later)
 - b. 000065 CHEM350-02 Organic Chemistry I. June-3 listed start date (although can start sooner or later)
 - c. 000066 CHEM360-01 Organic Chemistry II. June-3 listed start date (although can start sooner or later)
- d. Click "Register", and that should do it
- e. Admission into MSUM must be completed before you can register.

Notes:

- If repeating a course previously taken at NDSU to get a better grade, tricollege registration will replace earlier NDSU grade with this grade on your NDSU transcript.
- **Practical summary: if wanting to replace a bad NDSU grade, definitely register via tricollege. Otherwise, you'll save hundreds of dollars by just applying and registering via MSUM.**
