The following are the criteria in which Oral Presentations will be conducted in my *General Botany* (BIOL 305) class.

- Everyone will listen and respect the presenters at all time.
- You will, at all times, respect the points of view of the presenters.

• When you ask a question, put your hand up and wait for me to inform you when it is your turn to ask your question.

- When you ask a question, do so in a controlled, civil tone of voice.
- When you ask a question you will listen carefully to the reply.

• When the initial rounds of direct questions have been asked to the presenters, I will open up the floor to questions between students in the audience.

So, clearly, being disrespectful to your fellow students is not an option and will not be tolerated by me in any way, shape, or form!

Lastly, I consider cell phones going off during class incredibly disrespectful to both your fellow classmates and to me. Turn them OFF BEFORE entering the class room. *See the syllabus for my exceptions to this!*
