The exhibit area displays permanent collections and traveling exhibits. The Paul P. Federal Observatory houses a 16-inch reflecting telescope capable of projecting celestial images to the auditorium via a television camera. The telescope is suitable for public programming, college courses, amateur astronomers, and astronomical research.
