Major Langhorn's recais as military attache at America's Berlin embassy.

All the American military observers recalled from the German army.

Gifford Pinchot's exclusion of a relief worker from Belgium.

The German embassy's intimation that Thresher, the American killed when a German submarine destroyed the steamship Falaba, brought his fate on himself by entering the war zone.

The embassy's open reference, in connection with Odenwald incident at San Juan, Porto Rico, to an American attack on the ship.
